Our Programmes

1 Online Expression & Civic Space

The programme is dedicated to platform governance, content moderation and the preservation of fundamental rights in the online space. It seeks to:

- Ensure online platforms are transparent, accountable, and respect human rights;
- Protect user rights online, in particular, freedom of expression and access to information;
- Combat online harms such as hate speech and online gender based violence.

2 Equity & Data

The programme ensures that fundamental rights are upheld in tech policy and regulation, advocating for:

- Human rights risks and harms to be assessed, documented and addressed in the development and deployment of AI systems and models.
- Transparency, explainability and remedies for individuals affected by automated processes.
- The availability and accessibility of robust, publicly available information on new technologies.

3 Security, Surveillance & Human Rights

The programme advocates for strong privacy protections to:

- Ensure individuals' personal information is secure from unwarranted government surveillance and law enforcement overreach.
- Ensure government accountability and adequate checks and balances to safeguard fundamental rights.
- Advocating for the development, use and protection of strong encryption technologies to protect communications and data from unauthorised access.
